

SABG Bulb & Seed Exchange 2025

Below are listed all bulb and seed donations. It has been a difficult year, particularly for seed, and the number of items donated is down; we should all thank the members who have donated material. As always, some seeds and bulbs/corms are in extremely short supply. Whilst we will try to fulfil all requests, it is hard to split a single bulb six different ways.

Naming

Species are listed below using the names provided by the donors. In a few cases, the spelling of names has been corrected, but as a voluntary organisation with limited resources, please bear in mind that we are not able to check the accuracy of these identifications. I have included *Polyxena* within *Lachenalia*. Plants we have previously grown as *Empodium flexile* or *E. namaquensis* are now ***Empodium elongatum***. Plants we have previously grown as *E. plicatum* are now ***Empodium flexile***.

Ordering

On receipt of the list, please send your wishlist to me, Jon Evans, 46 Upper Way, Farnham, Surrey, GU9 8RF, UK, or to jonevans46.uw@btinternet.com. I will acknowledge every email request I receive, usually within 24 hours, so if you don't receive a response, please try again, and copy in the secretary, Richard White (richard@sabg.uk) – your request may have vanished into the ether. However, **please note that I will not have access to email on 17th August**, so there will be a short delay before I can acknowledge early requests. Please get your requests back to me **by 30th August**, as I will start dispatching items in early September.

Your request should include:

- **Your postal address**
- **Up to 10 first choices.** I will try to satisfy everyone's first choices before looking at additional items requested.
- **Any other items** you would like to receive. There is no limit to how many items you may request.

Please order by using the numbers alongside the descriptions. If you want a particular species but don't care which donation, just give the name of the plant and 'Bulb' or 'Seed'.

If you have not donated bulbs or seed, the Committee expects you to make a donation to cover the cost of postage and packing. The following table suggests minimum amounts:

You can send cheques drawn on a UK bank or UK postal orders payable to "SABG", or make a bank transfer to 'Southern African Bulb Group', sort code 60-01-31, account number 59755709. In the latter case, please specify your name as the reference so that we know who it's from. Please don't send postage stamps.

Paypal

We cannot directly accept credit or debit card payments, but if you have a PayPal account you can pay that way. Overseas members may find this helpful.

To use PayPal, log into your PayPal account using a Web browser or the PayPal mobile app, click on "Send" (or "Send & Request", then "Send Money") and enter the address **pay@sabg.uk** or the user name **@paysabg** into the box. You should see the SABG Lachenalia logo and "Southern African Bulb Group", and a space to enter the amount to pay, in (GBP). You may only be able to enter digits for the pounds and pence, not a period ".", so watch carefully where the decimal point appears as you type!

Please add a brief note describing what the payment is for, e.g. 'Exchange 2024'. Include your name if your PayPal account uses a name which we might not recognise. Select or accept "**Paying for an item or service**". If it says "Sending to a friend or to family", click on "Change" and select "Paying for an item or service". **A "shipping address" may be shown, but I won't see this, so make sure you sent me your postal address with your order.** Click on "Send money now".

Overseas Members

We are only able to send material to overseas addresses in ways complying with their government's regulations (i.e. no mis-labelling of contents etc), and only when conforming with those regulations is neither too onerous, nor expensive. We expect the relevant member to be able to guide us in following their government's requirements. Although we'll do our best to comply with the regulations where possible, we cannot be held responsible for any bulbs or seeds which are confiscated.

A Phytosanitary certificate is now required to send packages to the EU, and to Australia. This would be expensive and a difficult administrative burden, and we regret that as a result we are unable to send bulbs or seeds to EU or Australian addresses at this time.

Notes from Carl Garnham

Gloxinia (Sinningia) tubiflora – as previously, but over the past year I have tried tip cuttings with two half-grown leaves the largest leaves on them, and they almost never fail and get going very quickly. I have grown the mother plant in a half-shaded spot in a corner, on the floor of the greenhouse this year and it has flowered well.

Asparagus suaveolens – seedlings from 3 inch pots. Adult plant is broadly similar in appearance to culinary asparagus – a tuberous sub-shrub to around 1m tall. From Silverhill seed. Highly scented flowers – one for the floor of the greenhouse in a corner, or conservatory, or grow as a house-plant. Place outdoors for the summer so that full light, wind and breezes, or an occasional rough shake by hand, encourage thicker, stiffer stems, otherwise it can become very lax.

Dietes iridooides. Does not like heat or very bright light although it will survive them. Hardy to at least -7C if dry. Makes a better house-plant in bright but filtered/indirect light than one for the greenhouse. Repeat flowers on the same peduncle.

Pseudoprospéro firmifolia natalensis. Prefers to be kept damp during the summer growing season and must not dry out during the winter – something like a teaspoon of water each week in a 3 inch plastic pot. Evergreen. Flowers late summer into winter with the lax peduncle extending and continuing to flower for as long as there is sufficient moisture. Small pinkish flowers.

Tulbaghia acutiloba –Flowers supposedly scented, but not here with my nose, neither garlic/onion nor otherwise.

***Tulbaghia simmleri* – pink form**. The first offsets from plants that I have had for nearly 10 years, ex SABC. Grown here as a summer-grower with just a bare minimum of water through the winter it often flowers in autumn and again in late winter when it is dry. It reputedly does well as a winter-grower and then offsets more freely...reputedly..... Large flowers with a very nice scent with no hint of garlic/onion until the flowers start to fade.

Albuca (aff.?) concordiana – bought as a non-existent species of *Albuca*. Lax grey-green leaves to around 20cm long with a helical twist, 6mm wide. Tall spikes of flat green and yellow flowers with a citrus scent that doesn't travel very far but is nonetheless very obvious and very pleasant.

(x)*Cooperanthus hortensis* – presumably a hybrid between what were *Cooperia* and *Habranthus*, now both regarded as *Zephyranthes*, and *Cooperia* now a genus of parasitic worms. Ex bulbs from Himalayan Gardens – photos on their website, although the foliage shown is mostly *Platynerium*. Likes to bake in full sun – grown here on a high shelf in the greenhouse, so the plants will see well over 40C at times. Large, very attractive flowers if it comes at least roughly true from seed.

Sansevieria parva - pale clone, small-growing, floriferous with great scent. Offsets via runners (very similar to strawberries). Note that individual *Sansevieria* growths/rosettes are monocarpic in all species. Surface sow and provide 20-25C for germination For anyone that has grown them, germination/progression from seed is very similar to palms. A darker, larger clone is frequent in trade as *S. kirkii* "friends".
